TRILITY, John Holland and MPC Group consortium awarded contract to deliver River Murray to Broken Hill Pipeline

Sydney, 23 October 2017: A consortium of John Holland, MPC Group and TRILITY has been awarded the contract by WaterNSW to design, build, operate and maintain a new 270km water supply pipeline from the River Murray in Wentworth to Broken Hill.

John Holland MPC Group Joint Venture will design and construct the River Murray to Broken Hill Pipeline at a total project cost of \$467 million.

John Holland TRILITY Joint Venture will then undertake the operations and maintenance of the pipeline for a fixed price 20-year contract sum of \$107.3m.

The pipeline will provide long-term water security for the Broken Hill community, enabling it to thrive. It will supply up to 37.4 megalitres of a peak daily demand of raw water to Essential Water in Broken Hill as the local water service provider.

Managing Director, Francois Gouws, said TRILITY has been providing water supply services in New South Wales for over 25 years and brings to the team particular experience in servicing regional communities.
